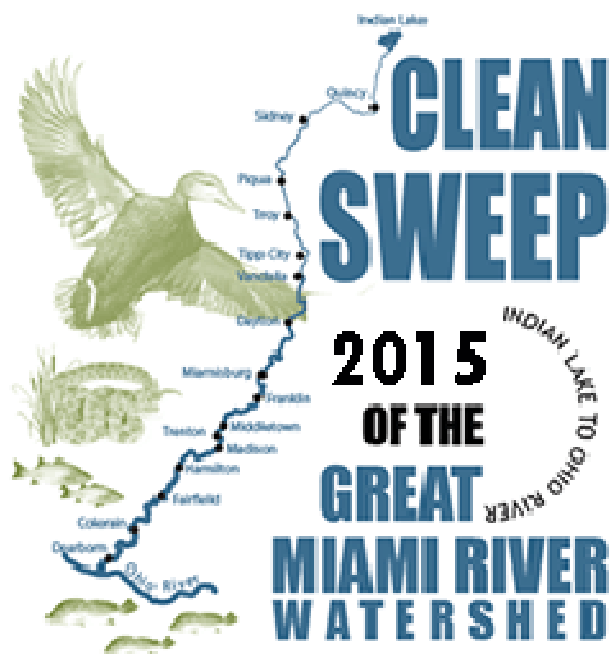


*Cool off this Summer!*
